(2) not less than 30 percent for projects described in subsection (d) that connect to airports
that are medium hub airports (as defined in section
47102 of title 49, United States Code) as of the
date of enactment of this Act.

17 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Federal share of the
18 cost of a project carried out with a grant under this
19 section shall be determined in accordance with sec20 tion 120 of title 23, United States Code.

(2) NON-FEDERAL SHARE.—Notwithstanding
any other provision of law, an eligible entity may use
toward the non-Federal share of the cost of a project
carried out with a grant under this section—
